



Desktop Alerts

Desktop alerts send notifications for account activity based on Member-selected criteria.

Alerts Step-by-Step

Use the following steps to set up alerts.

Step	Action
1	Click the More Links (☰) menu on the top right of the screen.
2	Click the Alerts menu at the right of the screen.
3	Click the Subscriptions Alerts menu at the left of the screen.
4	Subscription Alert options may include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Balance Alerts• Balance Summary Alerts• Check Cleared Alerts• Transaction Alerts• Extended Courtesy Pay Alerts• Loan Due Alerts
5	Click the Accounts tab or the Cards tab.
6	Scroll to view your list of available Subscription Alerts
7	Click to select the drop-down arrow and choose an account you want to set an alert for.
8	Use the toggle switches to turn Account and/or Card alerts on or off. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Toggling On means you will receive Account and/or Card alerts.• Toggling Off means you will not receive Account and/or Card alerts.• Alerts can be sent to your Email and/or Phone.
9	Click the Edit icon to set alert preferences.
10	Click the Security Alerts menu at the left of the screen.
11	Security Alerts options may include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Security Alerts• Login Alerts• Transfer Alerts



Alerts Step-by-Step Continued

Use the following steps to set up alerts.

Step	Action
12	Use the toggle switches to turn Security, Login and/or Transfer alerts on or off. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Toggling On means you <u>will receive</u> Security, Login and/or Transfer alerts.• Toggling Off means you <u>will not receive</u> Security, Login and/or Transfer alerts.• Alerts can be sent to your Email and/or Phone.
13	Click the Edit icon to set alert preferences.
14	Click the Alert History menu at the left of the screen and then: <ul style="list-style-type: none">A. Click and enter keywords in the Search field.orB. Use the Sent To drop-down arrow to narrow your search results.
15	Review how each Alert was sent, along with the date and time it was delivered in the Alert Message panel.
